Japanese Summer Program

July 14 – August 3, 2015

You will experience Japan next summer!



Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU) offers the three week Japanese Summer Course in 2015. The program aims at providing a comprehensive introduction to Japanese language and culture.

Students will develop their language skills, experience traditional Japanese culture such as classic tea ceremony, and increase their understanding of the Japanese society through field studies.

Program Contents

The 3-week program consists of 55 hours of Japanese language study and Field trips, and 15 hours of Japan Studies. Students will be evaluated according to class participation, oral presentation and weekly quiz. A certificate will be issued upon completion of the program.

■ Japanese Language (2 levels) + Field Trips

The Japanese language classes at two levels (Introductory and Beginner's) are designed for students who want to start studying Japanese or want to accelerate their language study in the intensive program. The class will be decided

according to the questionnaire result submitted with the application form.

- ◇ Introductory Class: For those with no prior knowledge of Japanese. (JLPT 5 or lower)
- ◇ Beginner's Class: For those with basic knowledge of Japanese, able to read Hiragana and Katakana, and understand and use basic Japanese. (JLPT N4 preparatory level)

■ Japan Studies

A variety of issues regarding contemporary Tokyo and Japan will be studied inside and outside of the classroom.

Program Length

Tuesday, July 14, 2015 – Tuesday, August 3, 2015

Fee

117,000 JPY

Tuition fee is waived according to the exchange agreement. This program cost includes accommodation fee, field-trips, and education materials. Not included in the program fee are meals, airfare, travel insurance, transportation between the University and accommodation, and daily expenses. The fee should be paid by overseas remittance no later than April 30. Details regarding the payment method will be sent after your application is accepted.

Cancelation Policy

Please be advised that once your application has been accepted and you have paid the fee, the following cancellation policy will apply:

Maximum 50% of the program fee will be forfeited in case of cancellation before June 13.

Maximum 100% of the program fee will be forfeited in case of cancellation after June 14.

The cancellation policy applies for any reasons. Any handling or service fees incurred for refunding the fee will be borne by the applicant. It will take two to three months to reimburse the program fee.

- ◇ For some summer programs, admission could be competitive and not all applicants are admitted due to the limited capacity of the program.
- ◇ The program schedule may be subject to change.
- ◇ Participants in the program are required to purchase traveler's insurance to cover medical costs incurred during the period of the stay in Japan at their own expense. Please submit the copy of insurance certificate before arrival.
